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INTERESTED IN CONSTRUCTION?

This Nationally Recognised course is suitable for those wanting:

- To gain a Trade's Assistant role in the construction industry.
- A pathway to an apprenticeship in carpentry, plastering, brick laying, stonemasonry, joinery and shopfitting, etc.
- To start a home maintenance business.

COURSE OVERVIEW

Duration: Duration can vary depending on location and cohort. Possible delivery formats include:

- 1 day per week for 20 weeks + 2—4 hrs self-paced study per week.
- 2 days per week for 10 weeks + 2 week work experience.
- 3 days per week for 5 weeks + 2 week work experience.

Work Experience Placement: A work placement is not mandatory but may be included as part of your course to gain industry experience.

Where: Training venues in Brisbane, Gold Coast, Sunshine Coast and Townsville. Contact us for upcoming venues and start dates.

Equipment: All student resources, equipment, building materials and personal protective equipment is provided, including a "High Vis" shirt.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- All participants must meet our minimum written, oral, numeracy and computer operating standards.
- Participants must have steel cap boots for practical components.
- Participants must be able to attend designated venues for practical/work placement.

ASSESSMENT

- Flexible and competency based. Participants will undertake a combination of written/oral assignments and practical components. Practical Projects are a series of real and simulated building projects.

COURSE OUTCOMES

- ⇒ Certificate I in Construction (CPC10120)
- ⇒ Construction Safety 'White Card' (required to access any construction zone)
- ⇒ Access to industry employment and apprenticeship opportunities
- ⇒ Credit for numerous units from 1st year apprenticeship



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ELIGIBILITY AND COST

This course is a funded qualification through the Queensland Government's Certificate 3 Guarantee funding. Eligibility:

- Be an Australian or New Zealand citizen, or Australian permanent resident (including humanitarian entrants), or a temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency.
- Permanently reside in Queensland
- Be 15 years of age or older and no longer at school
- not hold or be currently undertaking a certificate level III or higher qualification. This does not include certificate level III qualifications completed while at secondary school or abroad.

Cost

- \$100 (\$9.09/unit) - For participants who meet the eligibility criteria above
- \$50 (\$4.54/unit) - For concession card holders who meet the eligibility criteria above.

In some cases your Job Active Network (or DES) will cover this cost.

- Participants who do not meet the eligibility criteria above can enrol as a fee paying student. A course fee of \$2500 can be paid via a payment plan.

COURSE STRUCTURE

CPC10120 Certificate I in Construction consists of 11 units:

1. CPCCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry
2. CPCCWHS2001 Apply WHS requirements, policies and procedures in the construction industry
3. CPCCCM2004 Handle construction materials
4. CPCCCM2005 Use construction tools and equipment
5. CPCCCM1011 Undertake basic estimation and costing
6. CPCCOM1012 Work effectively and sustainably in the construction industry
7. CPCCOM1013 Plan and organise work
8. CPCCVE1011 Undertake a basic construction project
9. CPCCOM1014 Conduct workplace communication
10. CPCCOM1015 Carry out measurements and calculations

One of the Following Electives (depending on cohort)

1. CPCCOM2001 Read and interpret plans and specifications
2. HLTAID009 Provide cardiopulmonary resuscitation
3. RIIWHS204E Work safely at heights
