Get paid to learn a trade while you're still at school! This Nationally Recognised course is suitable for those undertaking a Carpentry School Based Apprenticeship (SAT). A SAT combines:

- Working for an employer 1 day per week.
- · Completing your school studies
- Completing scheduled units from the Certificate III in Carpentry

COURSE OVERVIEW

School Based Duration: Ideally students will complete the school based component of their apprenticeship over 2 years (Yr 11 & 12). A shorter timeframe is possible however this will impact the amount of time deducted from the full time apprenticeship on a pro rata basis.

Post School Duration: At the completion of Yr12 the student and employer will be given the option to roll the apprenticeship contract across to a full time apprenticeship. A 2 year school based apprenticeship will knock 1 year off the full time apprenticeship duration (normally 4 yrs down to 3yrs).

Rolling intake: commence anytime of the year.

Structure: Blended delivery with combination of online and face-to-face contact. No classroom or block training. Course consists of:

- **Theory:** online modules can be completed at any time. Supported by video resources and unlimited trainer phone/video conference and email support.
- Practical: On-site training and assessment conducted by experienced Tradies.
- On-the-Job: Learning is occurring every day when onsite! Our system effortlessly records all on-the-job learning. School Based Apprentices must complete 375hrs (50 days) of paid employment over each 12 month period.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- If you are completing this course as part of an apprenticeship you must be signed up to a carpentry apprenticeship through an Australian Apprenticeship Support Network (such as MRAEL or MEGT).
- It is an expectation that you will have access to a computer/device and the internet.
- Students must meet minimum Language, Literacy and Numeracy (LLN) skills.
- Participants must own or have access to all safety equipment required of the job role, including steel cap boots, hard hat, safety glasses, ear muffs, face mask/respirator, high vis vest, etc.
- Please discuss with Adapt any entry requirement issues as strategies can be put in place to assist.
