Any person commencing paid or unpaid work in a construction environment must hold a **Safety White Card**.

COURSE OVERVIEW

This course will cover the following:

- ⇒ Identify health and safety legislative requirements of construction work.
- ⇒ Identify construction hazards and risk control measures.
- ⇒ Identify health and safety communication and reporting processes.
- ⇒ Identify incident and emergency response procedures.

COURSE OUTCOMES

- ⇒ Construction Safety 'White Card' (required to access any construction zone).
- ⇒ Statement of attainment for CPCWHS1001 Prepare to work safely in the construction industry.
