COURSE OVERVIEW

Duration: 10 weeks:

- 8 weeks theory and practical training at designated training venue (2 days per week contact + 4 hrs per week self-paced learning)
- 6 days practical placement/work experience

Intakes: 4 intakes per year. Course start dates align with week 1 of school terms. Cut-off date for enrolments is 3 days prior to start date.

Where: Training venues in Brisbane and Gold Coast. Check our website for up-to-date venues and dates.

Equipment: All student resources, equipment, building materials and personal protective equipment is provided, including a "High Vis" shirt.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

- All students must meet our minimum written, oral, numeracy and computer operating standards.

ASSESSMENT

- Flexible and competency based. Participants will undertake a combination of written/oral assignments and practical components. Practical Projects are a series of real and simulated building projects.

ELIGIBILITY AND COST

This course is an approved lower level qualification through the Queensland Government's Certificate 3 Guarantee funding. Eligibility:

- Be an Australian or New Zealand citizen, or Australian permanent resident (including humanitarian entrants), or a temporary resident with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency.
- Permanently reside in Queensland
- Be 15 years of age or older and no longer at school
- not hold or be currently undertaking a certificate level III or higher qualification. This does not include certificate level III qualifications completed while at secondary school or abroad.

Cost

- Students who meet the eligibility criteria above will pay student contribution fee of \$100 or \$50 for concession card holders. In some cases your Job Network will cover this cost. Please discuss with your Job Network to see if you qualify.

Centrelink Payments

As an approved Centrelink course, you may qualify to receive Austudy, Abstudy, the Education Supplement, Newstart, Youth Allowance, or the Disability Supplement.
